Townsville Gets Skewered

The Townsville community has been treated to a taste of the Mediterranean with the unveiling of the state's first Skewerz Kebabz store last Friday.

Part of the \$180 million redevelopment at Stockland Townsville, the Skewerz Kebabz store is the result of months of menu development and product testing.

"Too many times the service is just not there, and this is one area that our team has been focusing on in the lead up to the opening- not only will you get a great product, but a smile at the same time."

Much more than just a traditional Kebab shop, Skewerz offers a wide variety of menu items inspired by the flavours of the Mediterranean.

Townsville will be the first Skewerz store to debut the new menu, which has been months in development.

"It very hard for me to pick just one favourite on the menu, but I'd have to choose the Skewerz and Dee's a fan of the Gyroz, both of which are new products that we're excited to introduce to Townsville," Andy said.

The store opening is part of a larger food court redevelopment by Stockland Townsville, which opened to the public on Friday.

"We are excited to present and deliver the new food court to our loyal customers and retailers," said Stockland Townsville Centre Manager, Ian Robertson.

"This bright new precinct is a new concept for our city, and we are pleased to welcome new retailers such as Skewerz Kebabz to the centre."
